**KPR SUMMER SCHOOL EXAMS JULY 31, REPORT CARD PICK-UP AUGUST 1**

Summer School is quickly coming to an end at the Kawartha Pine Ridge District School Board (KPR), with students at all sites writing their final exams Monday, July 31.

Report cards will be available for pick-up at all Summer School sites on Tuesday, August 1, from 8 a.m.-1 p.m. Alternatively, KPR encourages Summer School students and their parents or guardians to leave a self-addressed, stamped envelope at their Summer School office by July 31, and their report cards will be mailed directly to their home.

Marks needed for college and university should also have a self-addressed, stamped envelope left with Summer School, and a copy of the report card will be forwarded on each student's behalf.

Any report cards not picked up or mailed by August 1 will be forwarded to the student's home school, for pick-up during the week of August 28. Therefore, it is important that students needing their report cards to start college or university this September either pick them up where they attended Summer School on August 1, or leave a stamped, self-addressed envelope.

Summer School 2017 has been running since July 4 at Adam Scott Collegiate Vocational Institute in Peterborough, Clarington Central Secondary School in Bowmanville, and Northumberland Centre for Individual Studies, Cobourg.
