FAQ

How are buses organized for pick up and drop off? What measures are being taken to ensure safe arrival and departure?

Students at The Pines and Clarke are supervised during bus arrival and departure each day. The student drop off and pick up location is not within close proximity to the highway. Buses load and unload beside

the rocked green space between the two school driveways.

Students who require additional support and monitoring are assisted when getting on and off the bus.

At the end of each day, a team of adults confirms that all students are on the bus prior to buses being dismissed by the Principal team.
