During the course of the school year, it is recognized that from time to time, Kawartha Pine Ridge District School Board (KPRDSB) and/or schools may need to respond to inclement weather emergencies. To ensure the safety of all students and staff, it is critical that as a Board we prepare for these situations.

In rare circumstances, and in the interest of student and staff safety, the Director of Education has the authority, by the Board, to close schools due to extreme weather conditions that present hazardous conditions for transportation to/from school by any means for students and staff.

Communication to all stakeholders is critical in preparing for these situations. Supporting administrative regulation BA-20.1 Inclement Weather, outlines specific details to support school and system inclement weather plans and focus in the following areas:

- 2. School Closures
- 3. Transportation/Bus Cancellations During Inclement Weather
- 4. Employee Responsibilities and Remuneration During Inclement Weather
