POLICY STATEMENT

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Despite everyone's best efforts accidents do occur and therefore a detailed process is required to ensure that injured persons are attended to expeditiously.

All accidents, involving a student(s) and/or school purpose vehicle, no matter how minor, must be reported immediately to Student Transportation Services of Central Ontario (STSCO) and the school.

Operators of vehicles under contract to the Board, that are involved in an accident (either prior to the first pick-up or following the last drop-off), should also report the accident. This will assist staff in addressing inquiries from concerned parent(s)/guardian(s) and the media.

In the event of an accident, the driver's first responsibility is to the passengers.

It is the responsibility of the operator to notify the school and STSCO immediately of the accident. The school staff will be responsible for immediately contacting each student's parent(s)/guardian(s) as soon as possible and advising them of the accident. Where school staff is not available to contact families, the bus operator shall assume the responsibility.

Once advised, STSCO will notify the appropriate Education Centre personnel (i.e. superintendent, trustee, Corporate Affairs).

Administrative regulations will reflect the philosophy of this policy.
