Policy: SCHOOL ORGANIZATION

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The Board recognizes that school organization must be in accordance with the regulations and procedures, as outlined by the Education Act, the Ministry of Education, and the Board.

The Board acknowledges the importance of school organization which supports student learning and considers the best interests of students and staff.

The Board recognizes that school organization refers to such aspects as the schedule of daily sessions, class organization, timetables and class/staffing assignments.

The Board acknowledges that school organizational planning also considers the school year calendar and employee agreements.

- 1. School organization shall reflect the Board's belief in the principles of:
 - 1.1 the critical need for communication to the school community regarding all aspects of school organization;
 - 1.2 the importance of the compilation and maintenance of essential information relative to student enrolment and staffing; and
 - 1.3 the importance of the role and responsibilities of the principal, in consultation with school staff, the school community, and the superintendent, to develop and/or modify school organizational plans.
- 2. The administrative regulations for this policy describe procedures relative to school organization and reporting related statistical information and data.
